

MEDICAL AND HEALTH INSURANCE RESOURCES California

MEDICARE

- Health insurance for people age 65 or older, under 65 with certain disabilities, and any age with End-Stage Renal Disease (permanent kidney failure requiring dialysis or a kidney transplant)
- Medicare Part A covers inpatient care in hospitals, skilled nursing facility, hospice and home health care
- Medicare Part B covers doctors' services and outpatient care, as well as some preventive services
- Medicare Part C is health coverage run by private companies approved by Medicare
- Medicare Part D helps cover cost of prescription drugs

MEDI-CAL

- Pays for many health care services for certain needy residents of California. Your local County Welfare Department can help determine your eligibility for Medi-Cal. For Santa Clara County, the number to call is (408) 271-5600

CALIFORNIA MAJOR RISK MEDICAL INSURANCE PROGRAM (MRMIP)

- Is a program developed to provide health insurance for Californians who are unable to obtain coverage in the insurance market. There is a \$500 deductible. You can call 1-916-324-4695 for more info.

CALIFORNIA'S PRE-EXISTING CONDITIONS INSURANCE PLAN (PCIP)

- For Californians who are unable to obtain health insurance because of a pre-existing condition. Call 1-877-428-5060
